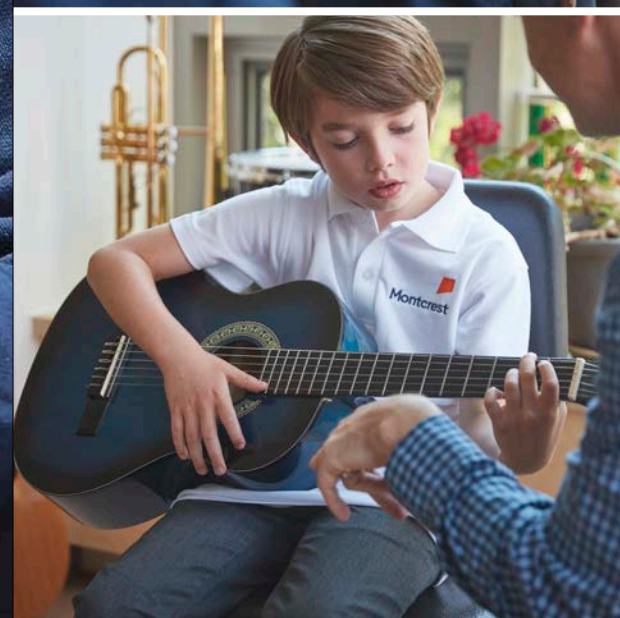
Number of Performing Arts and General Interest Clubs Per Year

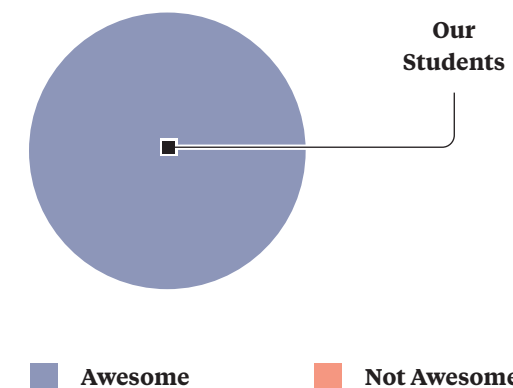
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Giving voice and choice.
