At Rutherford School, we are committed to the well-being of our students and their families. Our guidance and experience help them adjust to life in Canada as newcomers. We have caring staff who can speak students' native language and make them feel like at home. We provide students with plenty of support as they transition to their new life. (\$2,500.00 CAD/Academic School Year)

Immigration Support

In the past decade, we have assisted over 100 families and international students in obtaining study permits and tourism visas. We provide a **Letter Of Acceptance (LOA) Custodianship Declaration** and **Invitation Letters** for parents to come to Canada with their children. Our partnerships with immigration offices in Canada allow us to offer our clients the best advice possible.

University Admission Support

Our goal is to prepare each student for a unique university pathway based on their strengths and interests. Our team will help them submit all the required applications to get into the university of their choice.















Airport Transportation

The first-time international students are welcomed at the airport by our staff, who then drive them to their residences. They are also taken to the airport when they leave Canada to visit their families. They are accompanied by us until they check in to board the aircraft.

Home Stay

We work with many trustworthy families who enjoy hosting international students. They provide our students with homemade meal plans, a friendly environment and share extensive Canadian experience with them. (\$18,000 CAD/Academic School Year)

Medical Care

We assist students in finding the right medical insurance through our partner insurance brokers. Furthermore, we take students to walk-in clinics or emergency rooms depending on their health condition.

Opening Bank Account

We provide international students and their families with reference letters to open a Canadian bank account to help them with all necessary transactions.

Public Transportation

We show students how to navigate public transportation which is one of the most cost-effective ways to commute in Toronto.

Canadian Phone Number

We help international students register for a Canadian phone plan by using our school corporate account.

Communication with Parents

Our relationship with parents at RPS is very strong. Parents can easily access digital platforms to review school attendance, academic progress and learning skills. We have a private social media group for school announcements and events. Parents can directly communicate with school faculty through Zoom meetings.



Credit Transfer

The guidance office will grant equivalency credits to students who have completed high school in their home country. For each high school year spent in their home country, international students can earn 8 credits.

Credits granted for each grade from your home country

- Grade 9 8 Credits
- Grade 10 16 Credits
- Grade 11 ———— 24 Credits

OSSD Requirements

To earn a high school diploma in Ontario, students must:

- Earn 18 compulsory credits
- Earn 12 optional credits
- Pass the literacy requirement
- Earn at least two online learning credits
- Complete a minimum of 40 hours of community involvement activities
