7. Everyone (online & in-person) must complete a liability waiver prior to starting camp.
NOTE: Your child's profile needs your ADULT email address in order for you to receive camp related information.

REFUNDS & TRANSFERS

Notification required: Refund requests must be submitted by 5:30 PM on the Friday at least 2 weeks (10 full business days) before the camp start date. GNAG staff do not work on the weekends during the Summer.

Designed for open ended play, this program lets children create any experience through educational robotics- a humanoid character from a story, a moving carousel, a jumping frog, a race helicopter- anything they can imagine. Children

engage in playful learning, cultivate their curiosity for the technological world, explore problem solving and understand concepts such as sequencing, coding, cause and effect, programming, sensors, motors, gears and actuators. This is an engaging introduction to powerful ideas from robotics, computer science, and engineering in a structured, developmentally appropriate paradigm. Children are given the opportunity to learn programming, sequencing and engineering concepts without the need for a screen or tablet. Additionally, our program also appeals to children who are not Lego enthusiasts and to those children that have limited reading and writing skills. After being immersed in this program, young children will be able to engage in both computational thinking and engineering design while creating their personalized robots. Our facilitated workshop integrates the use of art materials, literacy, music and dance through robotics to deliver a unique and fun activity.

Robotics Square

Step-Up Leadership is designed for leaders who have previously participated in a Glebe Leadership program. This three-week session will take the skills learned from previous sessions and put them to work in the real world. All participants will be in the program the weeks of July 14 - 18 and August 5 - 8. Each leader will complete a volunteer placement week in a GNAG camps. These one-week placements will be scheduled either July 21 - 25 OR July 28 - August 1. FAQs 2025 SUMMER CAMP

1. Is there a limit to the number of camps I can register for this summer?

You can register your children for as many camps as you wish. We have more spaces and offerings this summer so there are tons of options!

2. Can my 3 year old, who will turn 4 in the fall and entering JK in September 2025, attend a full-day camp?

Sorry, our youngest campers this year must be four (4) on the first day of their first camp.

3. What are your ratios this summer?

Our camper to staff ratios are well above the Ministry of Education and City of Ottawa guidelines. Campers 9 and under have a ratio of 1:8; older camps have a ratio of 1:10.

4. Are you accepting volunteers?

Yes! We are excited to accept volunteers for summer at GNAG. All volunteers must be a minimum of 14 years old by the end of 2025. Volunteer applications will be released in April. Follow us on social media for application dates and details. **Pro-tip:** all inquiries should come from the youth themselves, not their parents.

5. What if I want to transfer camps?

If you are offered a spot on a waitlist and wish to transfer camps (and there is sufficient notice), please contact info@gnag.ca so we can facilitate that transfer for you, otherwise you may incur some refund fees.



6. Changed your mind and need a refund?

No problem. We just need enough notice. Refunds will have a fee and are available if we receive at least two weeks' notice for each camp (notification falls within a standard business day - before 5 pm).

A 7% administration charge applies on each camp refund. If you wish to transfer camps the same notification time is required. You can also get a full credit to your GNAG account provided we receive the same notification.

Please send a detailed email to info@gnag.ca if you would like to withdraw and receive a refund or a credit.

7. My child has an exceptionality, can they attend camp?

Some campers need a little extra support. Camp can be a stimulating environment, so we ask that you contact us before registering your child to discuss how we can ensure a rewarding experience for them.

Please email jason@gnag.ca **before registering** your child. Jason will need a few days to review your file and confirm if staff are available to support your child. Our resources are limited, but we strive to help as many children as possible.

8. What does it mean when GNAG says information is subject to change?

This refers to dates, out-trip locations, health and safety guidelines, and other details. While we aim for accuracy, mistakes can happen. If any changes occur, we will update registrants and correct the guide online.
