






















SCHOOL OVERVIEW








DISTRIBUTION OF GRADES

UNIVERSITY GUIDANCE



My time at Keystone School was extraordinary. I found it so easy to make new friends when I first came to Keystone School. The students and teachers both made me feel so welcome.


My teachers were fantastic motivators, and the academic program was excellent.


