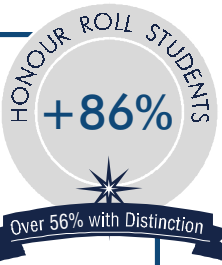


## The HNMCs Advantage

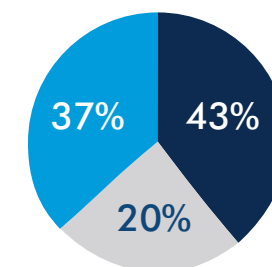
